• Visitors must stay seated as ride is in motion


- Visitors must be able to step up into surrey
- Hot chocolate offered after ride


ASTE

- Low impact on this sense
















**CROSS-COUNTRY SKIING**


OUTDOOR POOL

- Sound of bell from climbing wall


- Outdoor/natural lighting

- Potential scent of chlorine






